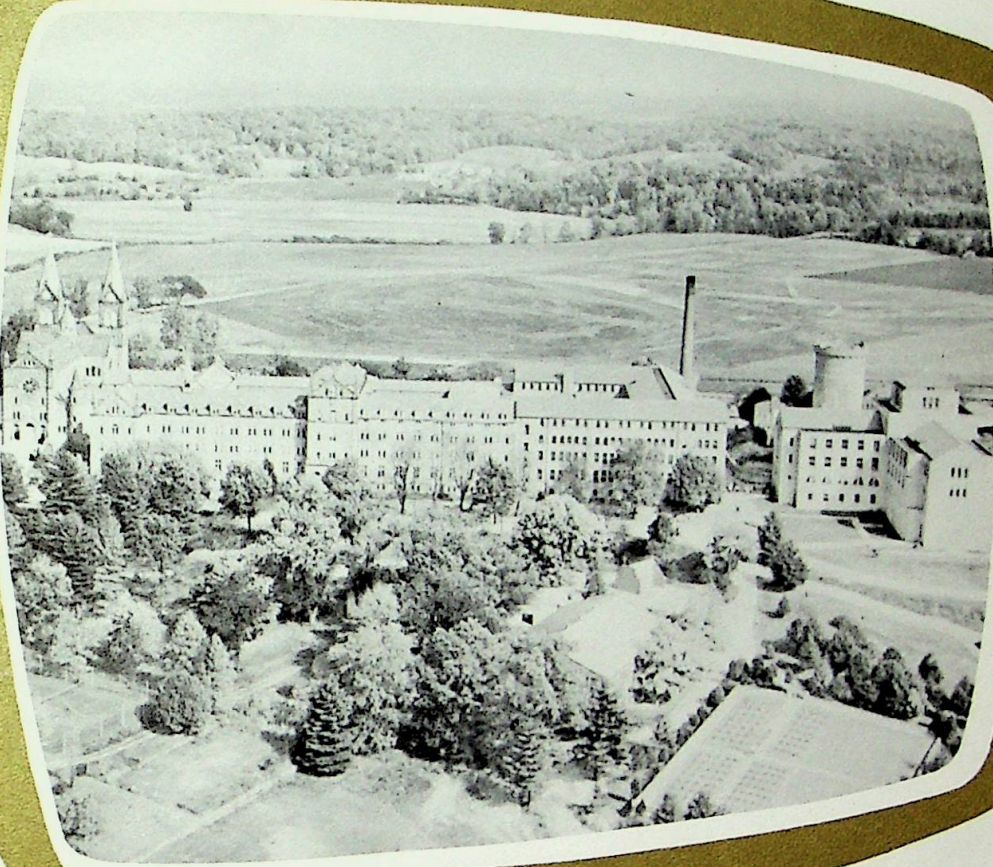

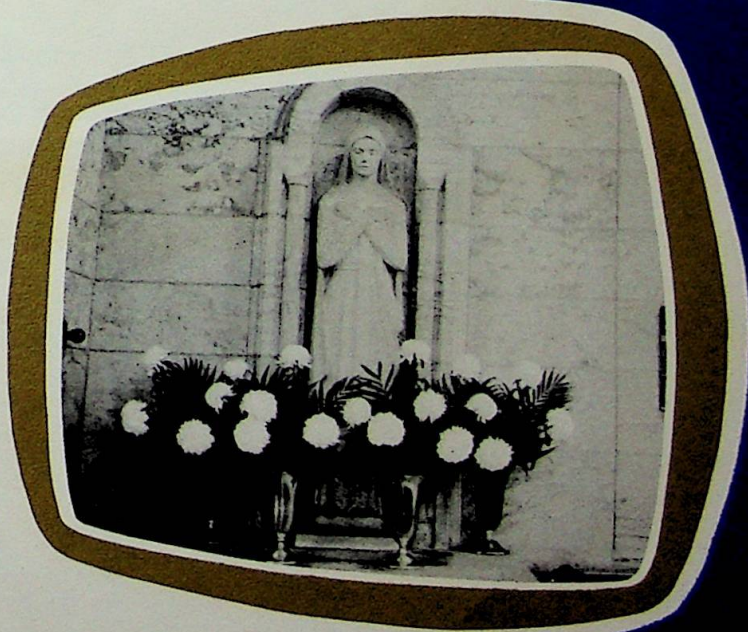

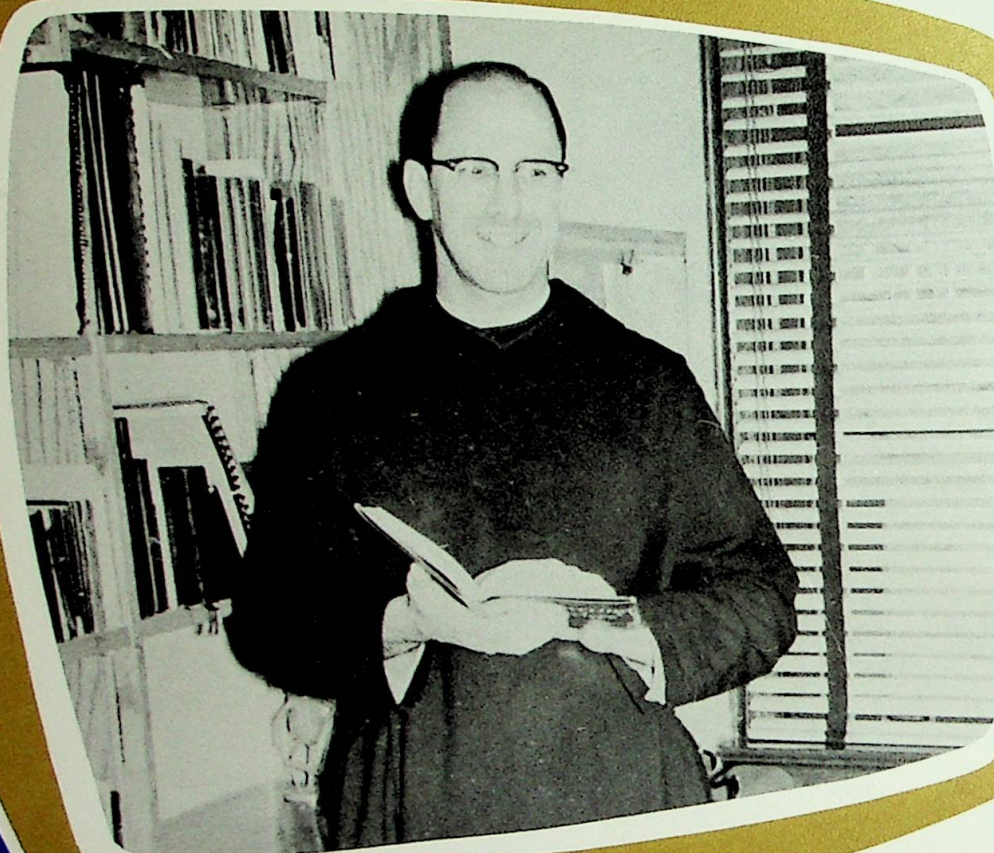

In gratitude to Father Archabbot for everything that he has accomplished in our behalf, we sincerely pray that God will guide, assist, and bless him always.



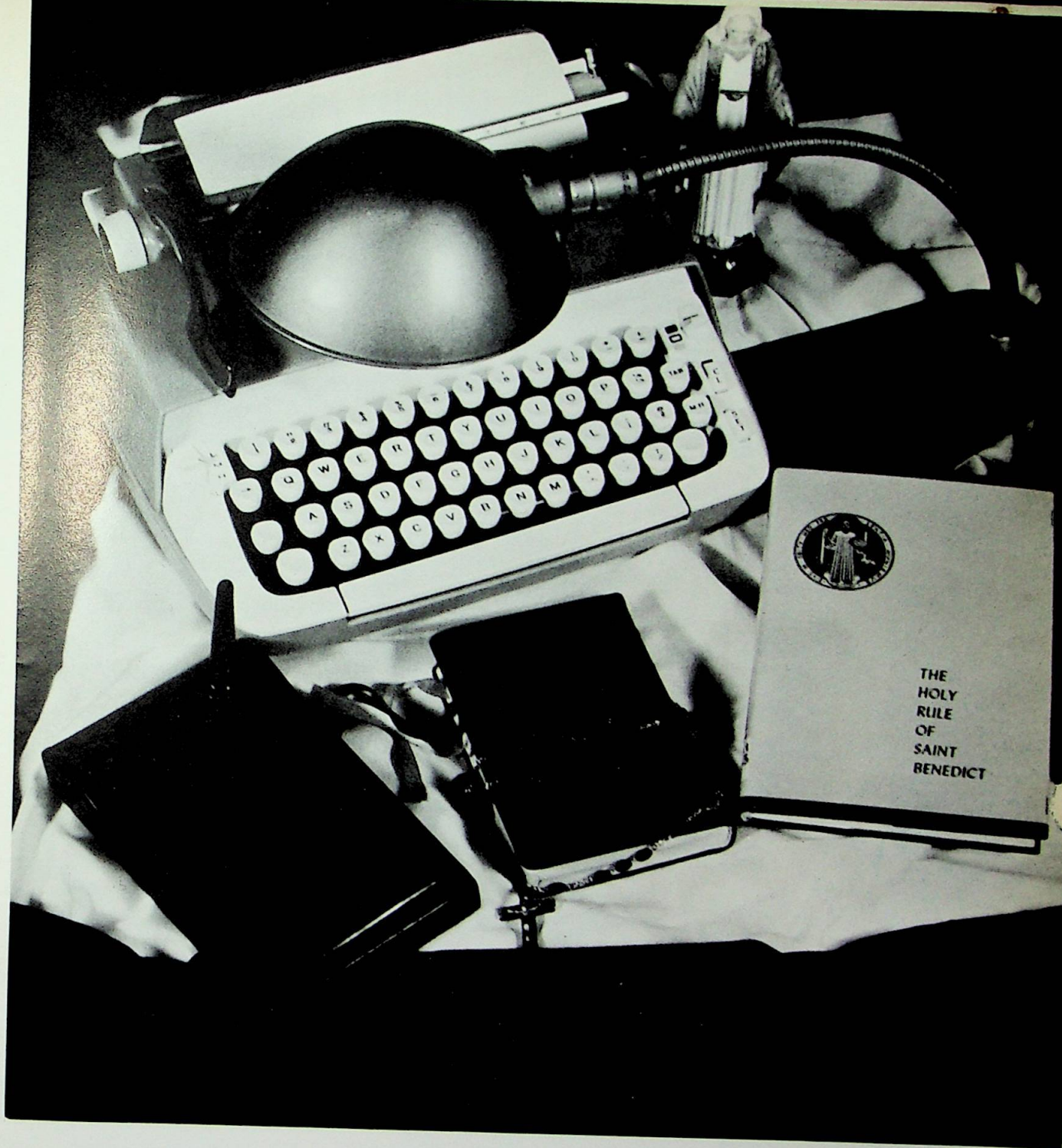


Dedication
