BOUNDARIES OF SAINT ANTHONY PARISHDUBOIS COUNTY

- Southern: From the Jefferson-Ferdinand-Jackson township lines due west on the Jackson-Ferdinand township line to the western extremity of section 3 of Jackson township and then turning due north to the line separating sections 4 and 33 of Jackson township and continuing due west on said section line to the Pakota-Jackson township line.
- Western
&
Northern: From the Jackson-Pakota township line due north on said township line to the Pakota-Bainbridge-Jackson township lines and continuing due east on the Jackson-Bainbridge township line and continuing due east into Jackson township along the line separating sections 17 and 20 of Jackson township, and then continuing due north on the line separating sections 17 and 16 of Jackson township to the Jackson-Marion township lines, and then turning due east on the Jackson-Marion township line to the section line separating sections 9 and 10 of Marion township and turning due north and continuing along said line to the point of its crossing Hall creek and continuing along Hall creek to the Jasper-Schnellville Road; and continuing in a southeasterly direction along the Jasper-Schnellville Road to its junction with the Saint Anthony-Celestine Road.

Eastern: The eastern boundary shall be the
 Jackson-Jefferson township line,
 exepting sections 13, 18, & 19
 (of Jackson township) which are
 in the Schnellville territory.

Pastors are reminded that Catholics are
permitted to attend Mass and any other church
services in any other church of their choice.

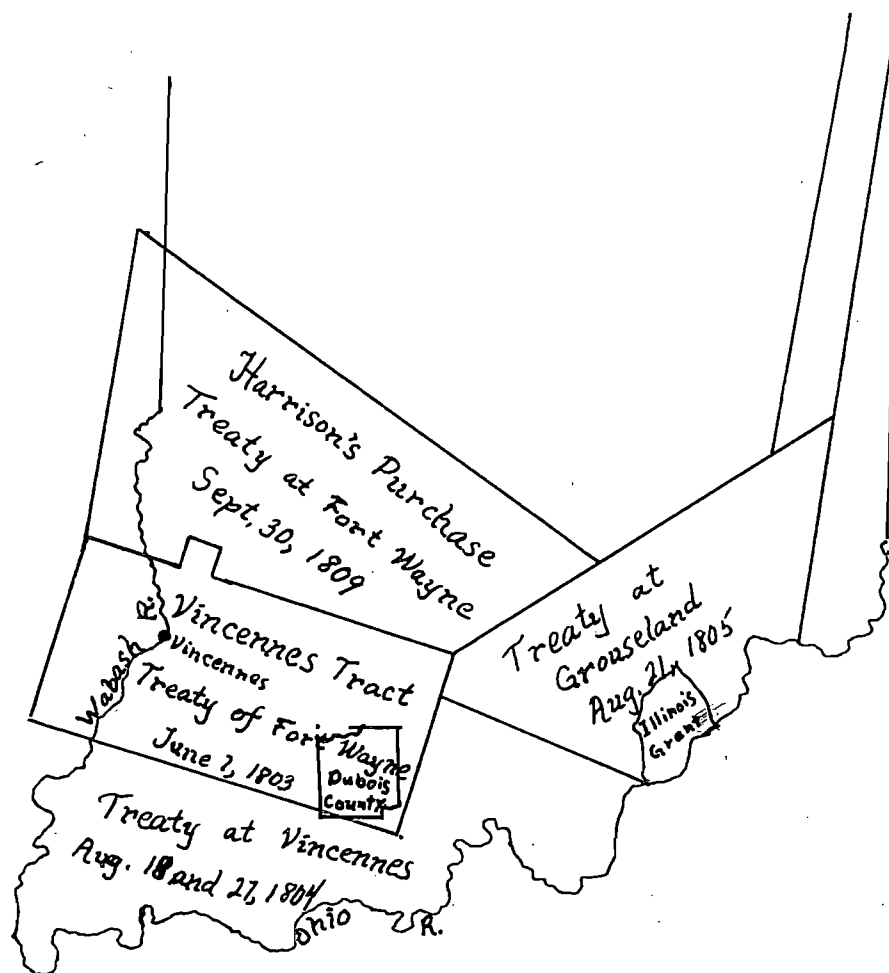

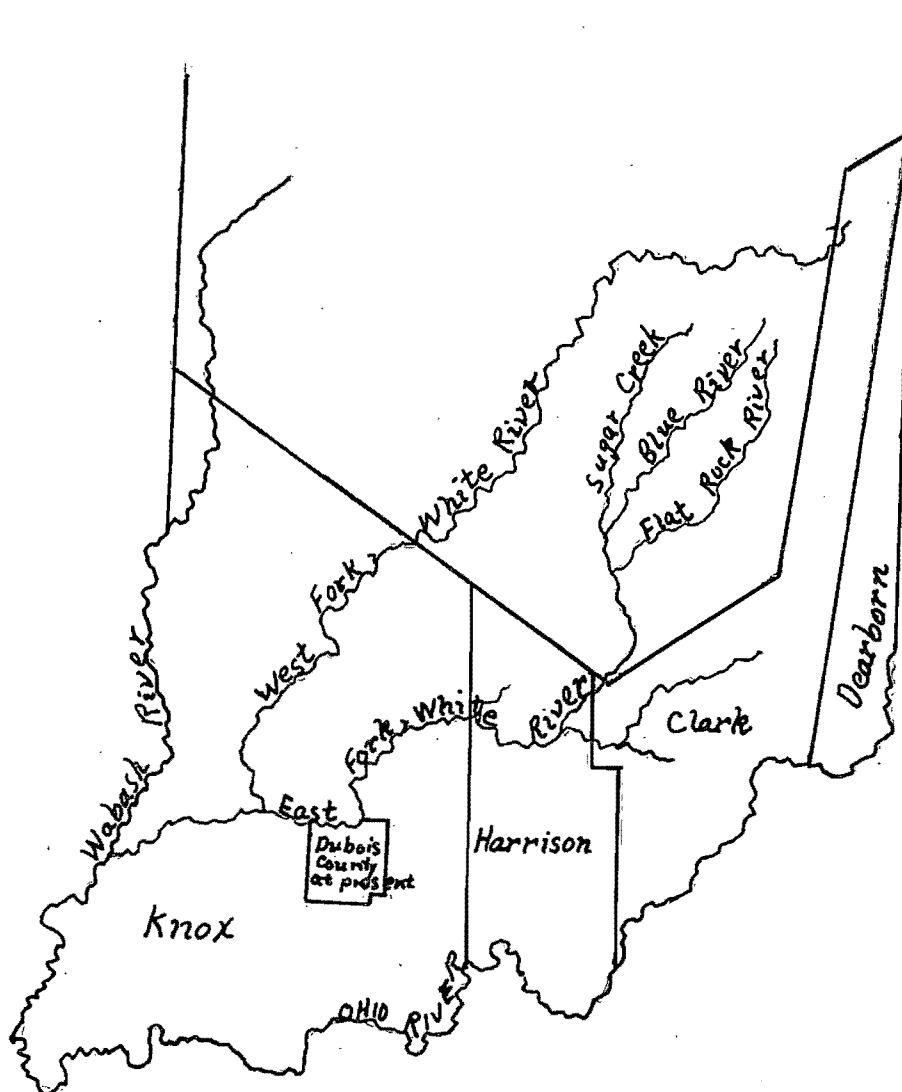

LAND PURCHASES FROM THE INDIANS

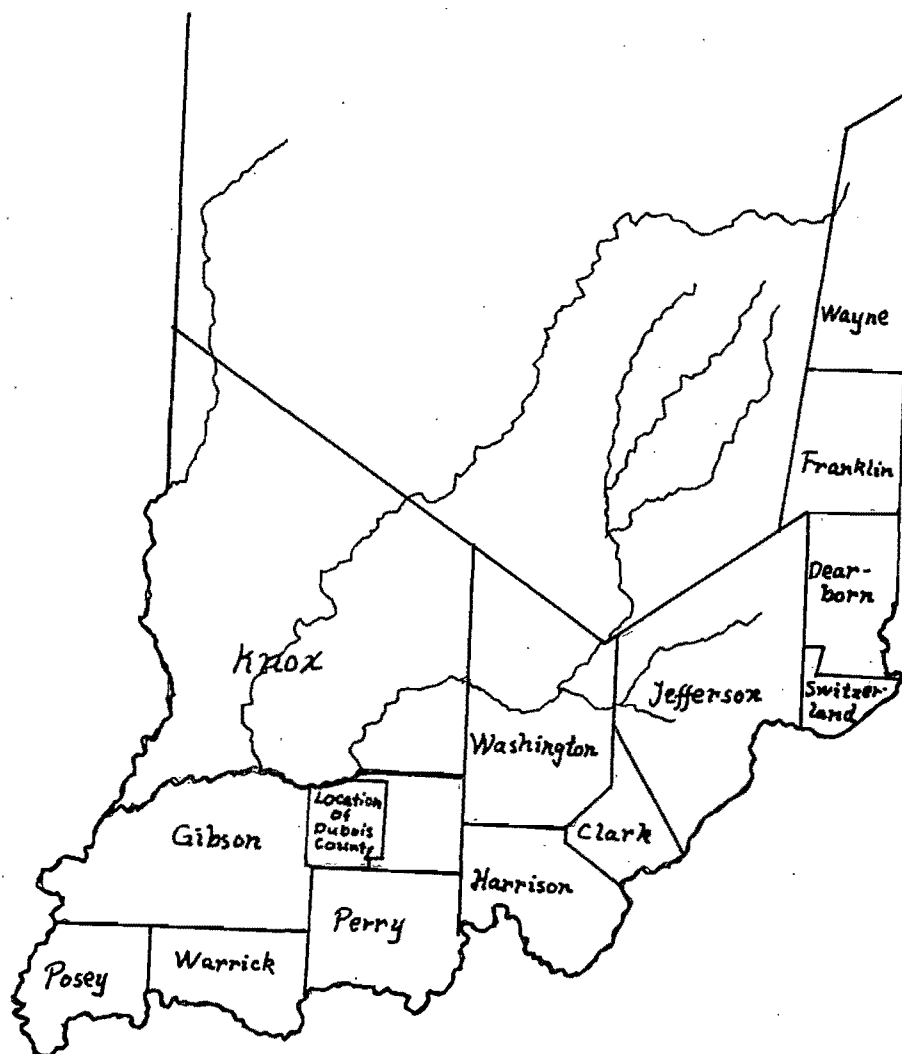

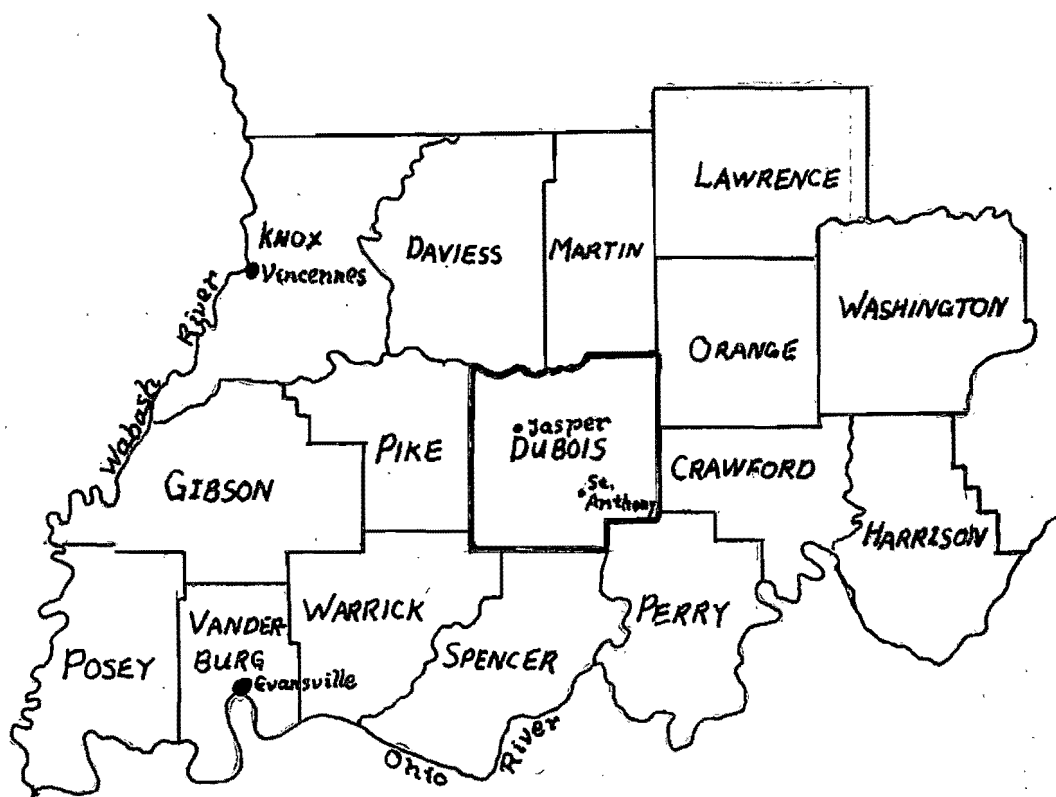

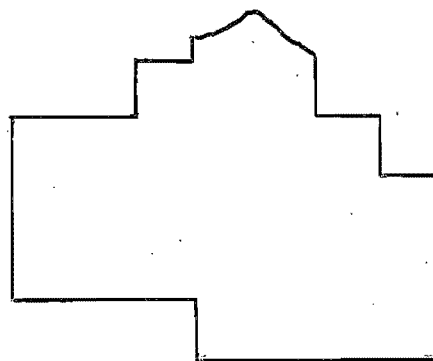
SOUTHERN INDIANA COUNTIES, 1814

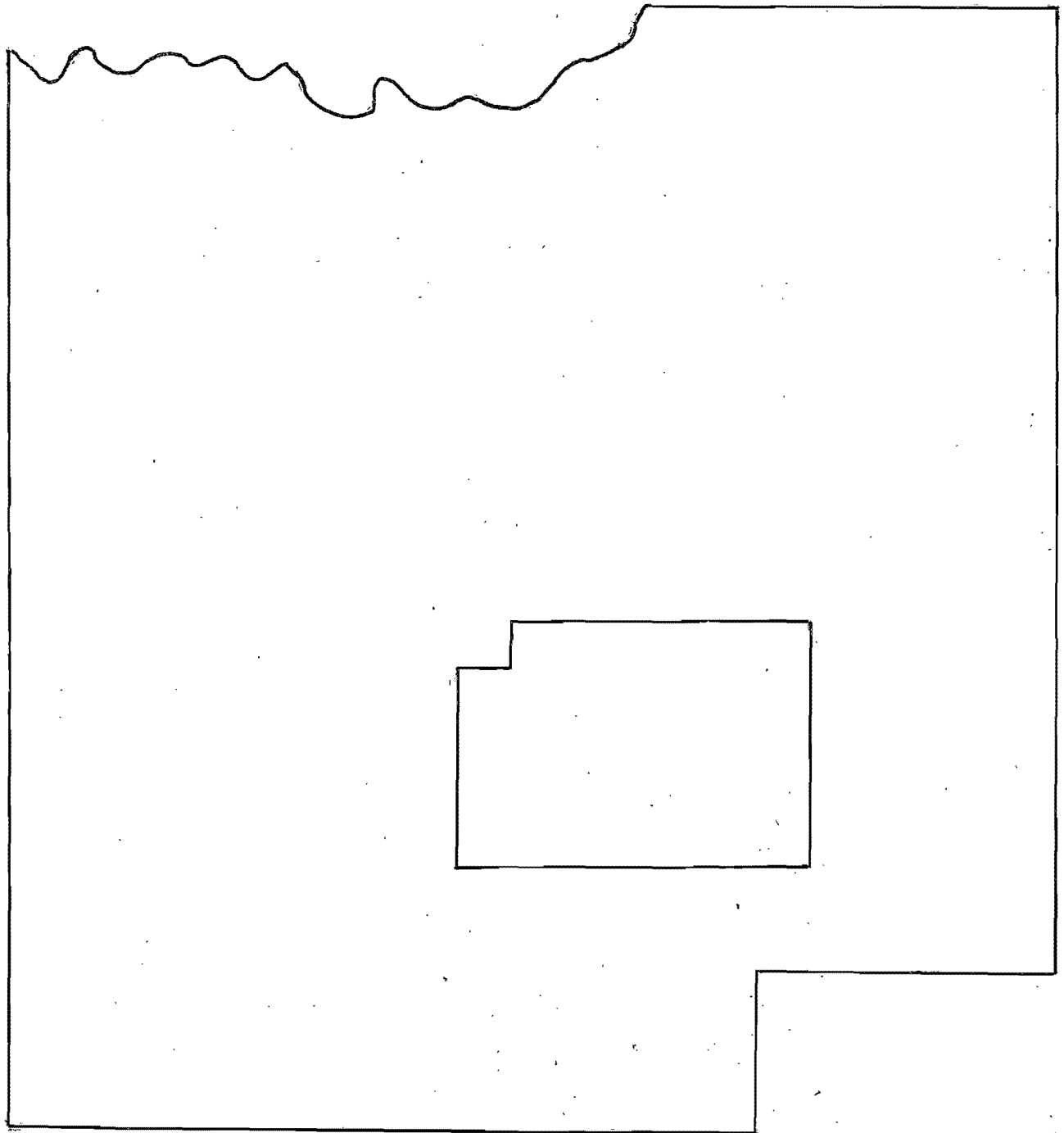

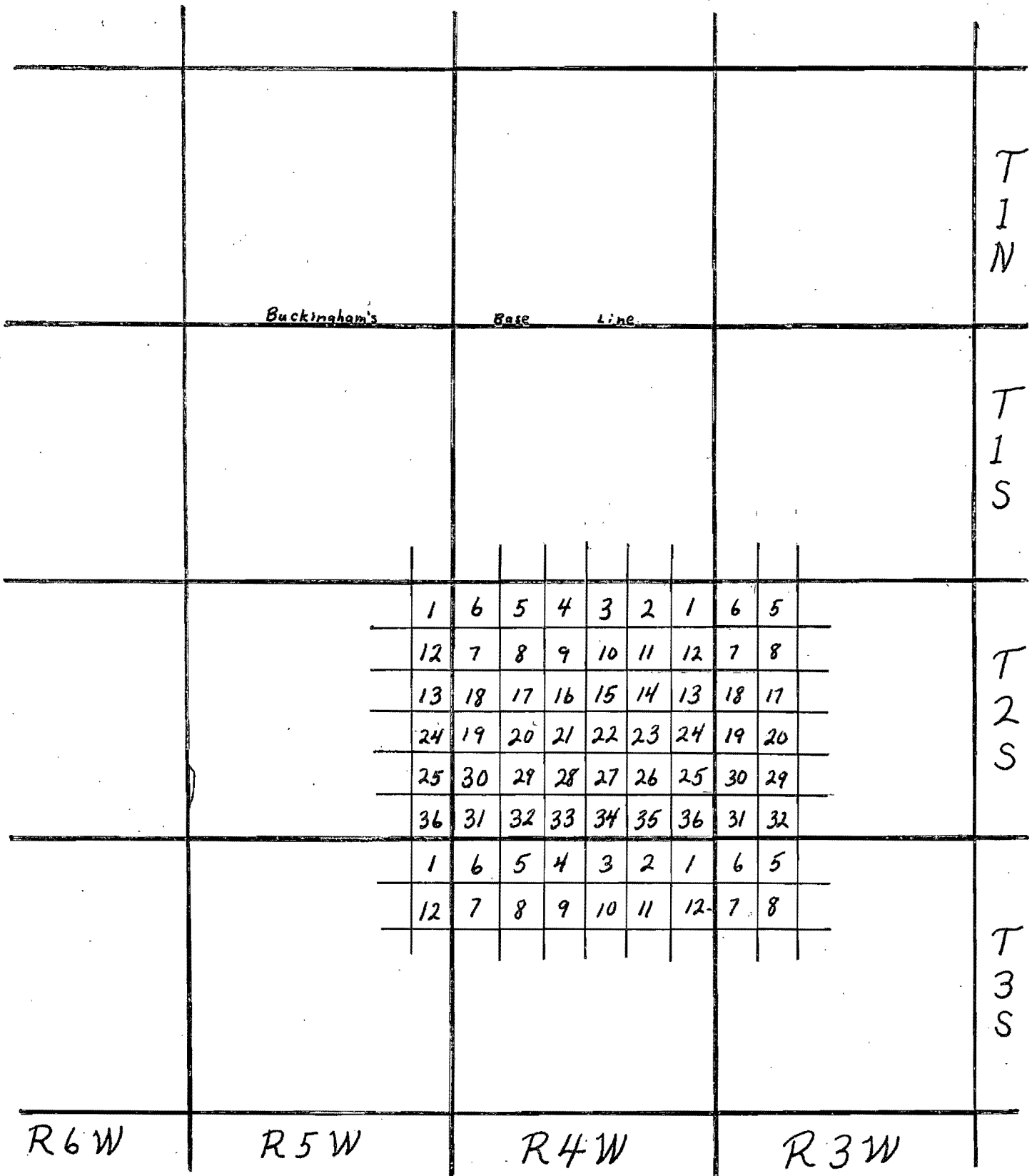
COUNTIES IN SOUTHERN INDIANA AT PRESENT



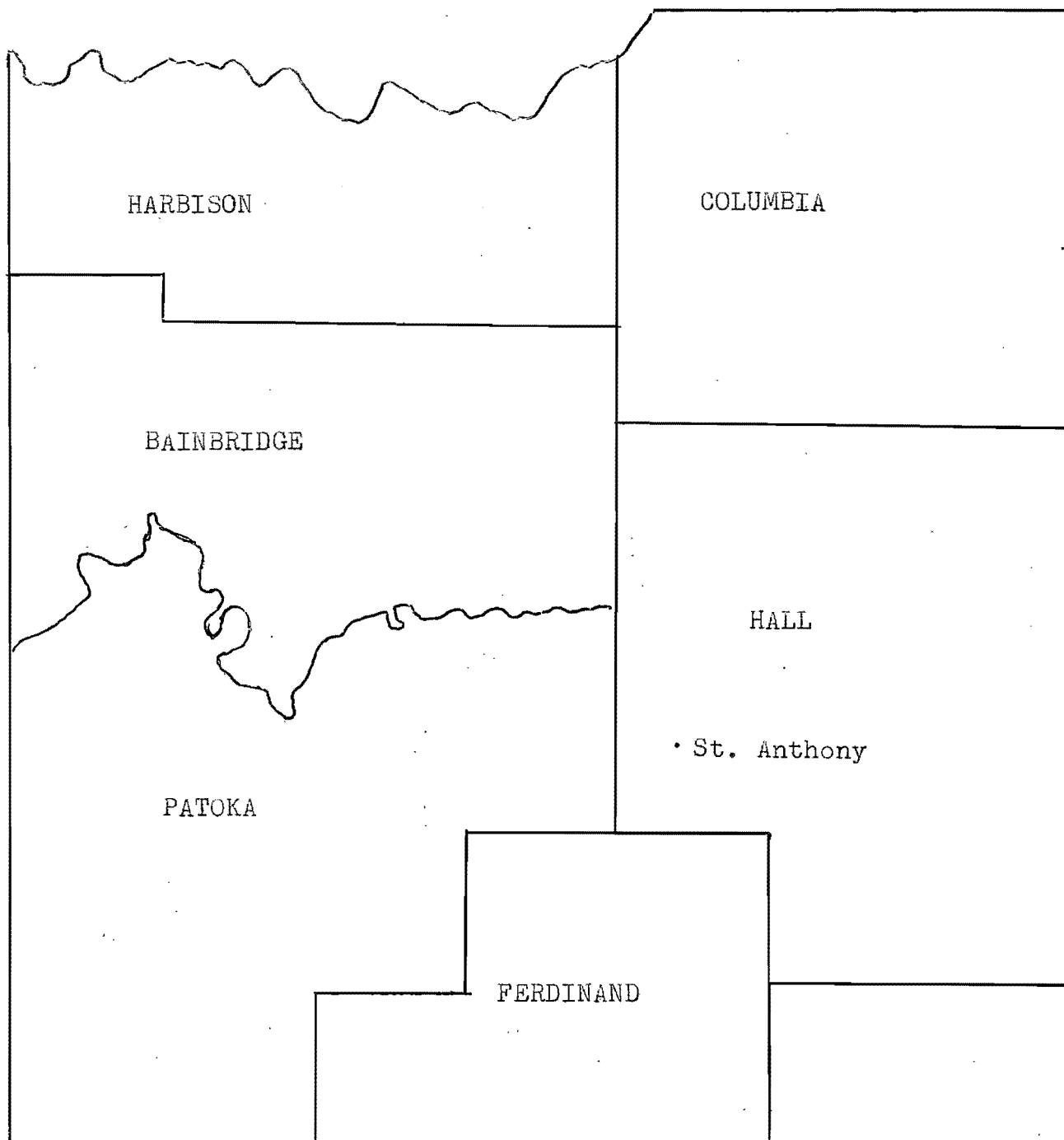
MAP OF THE PRESENT BOUNDARIES OF

DUBOIS COUNTY AND JACKSON TOWNSHIP

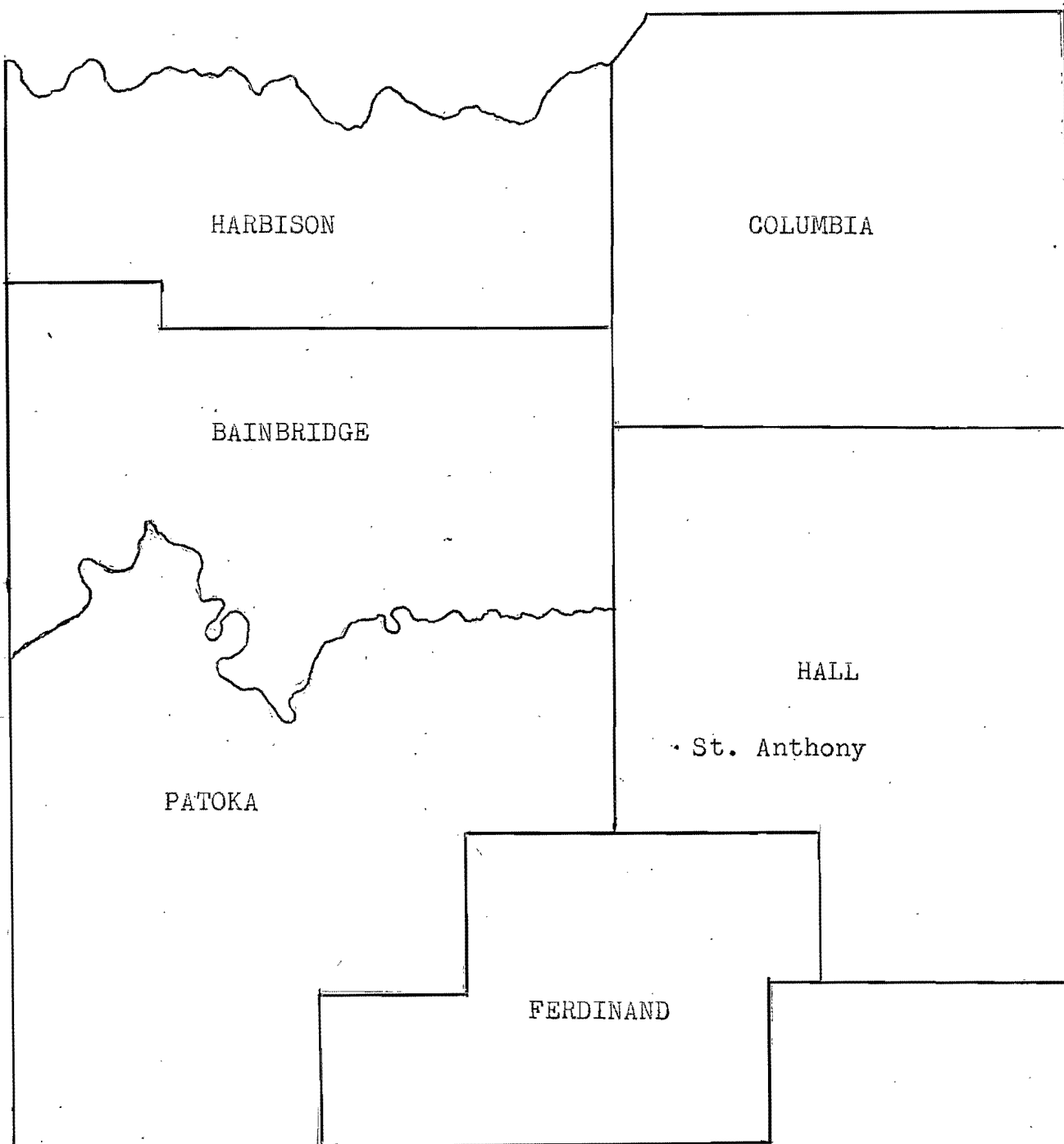


CONGRESSIONAL TOWNSHIPS IN, OR PARTLY IN

 SECTION DIVISIONS IN PERTINENT AREAS



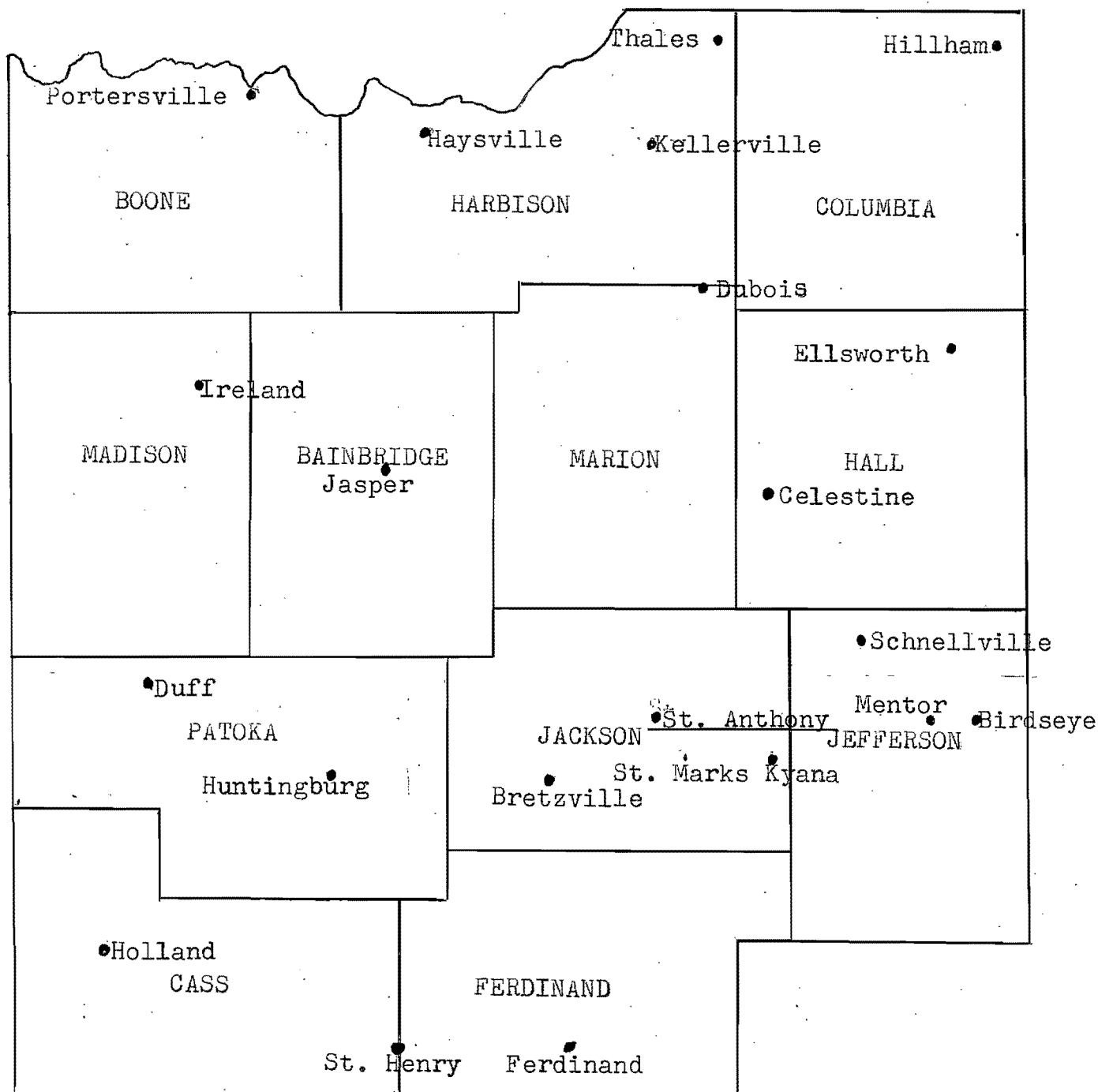

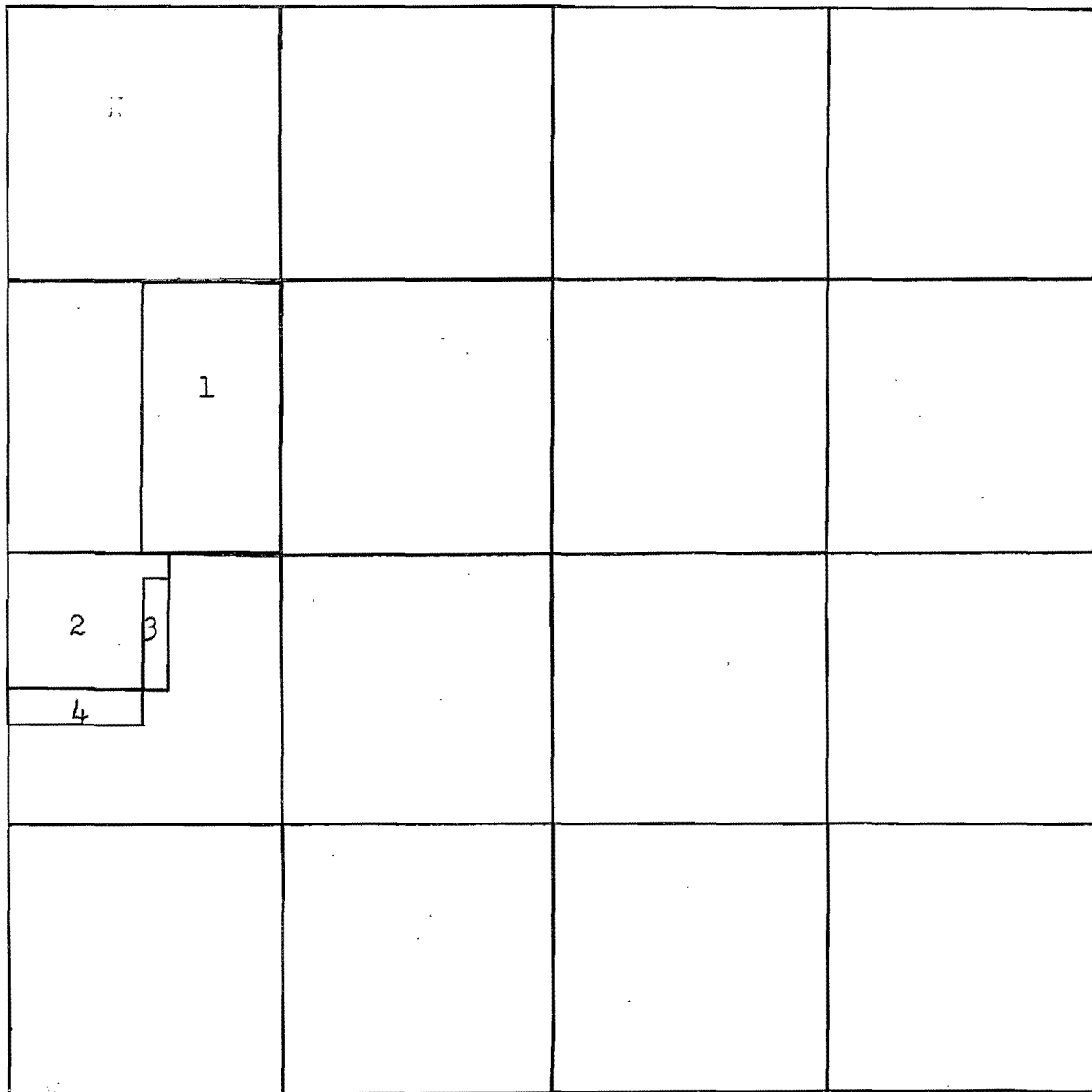

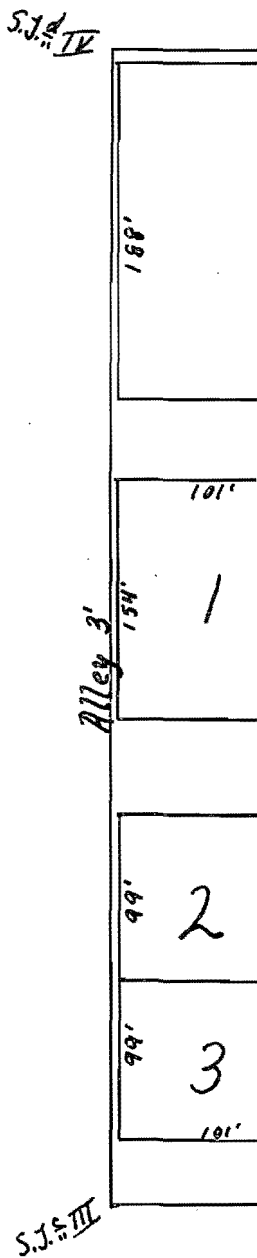

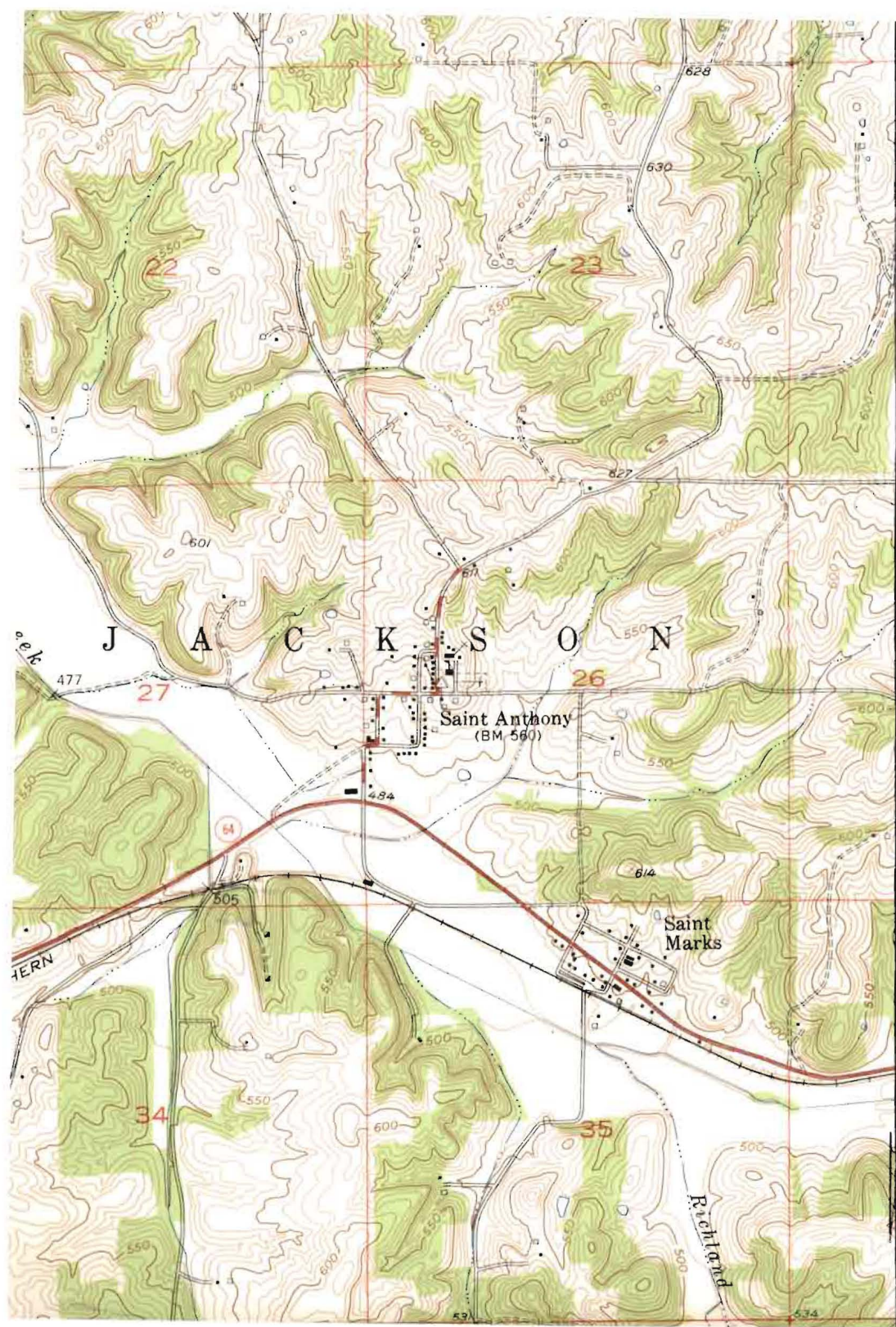

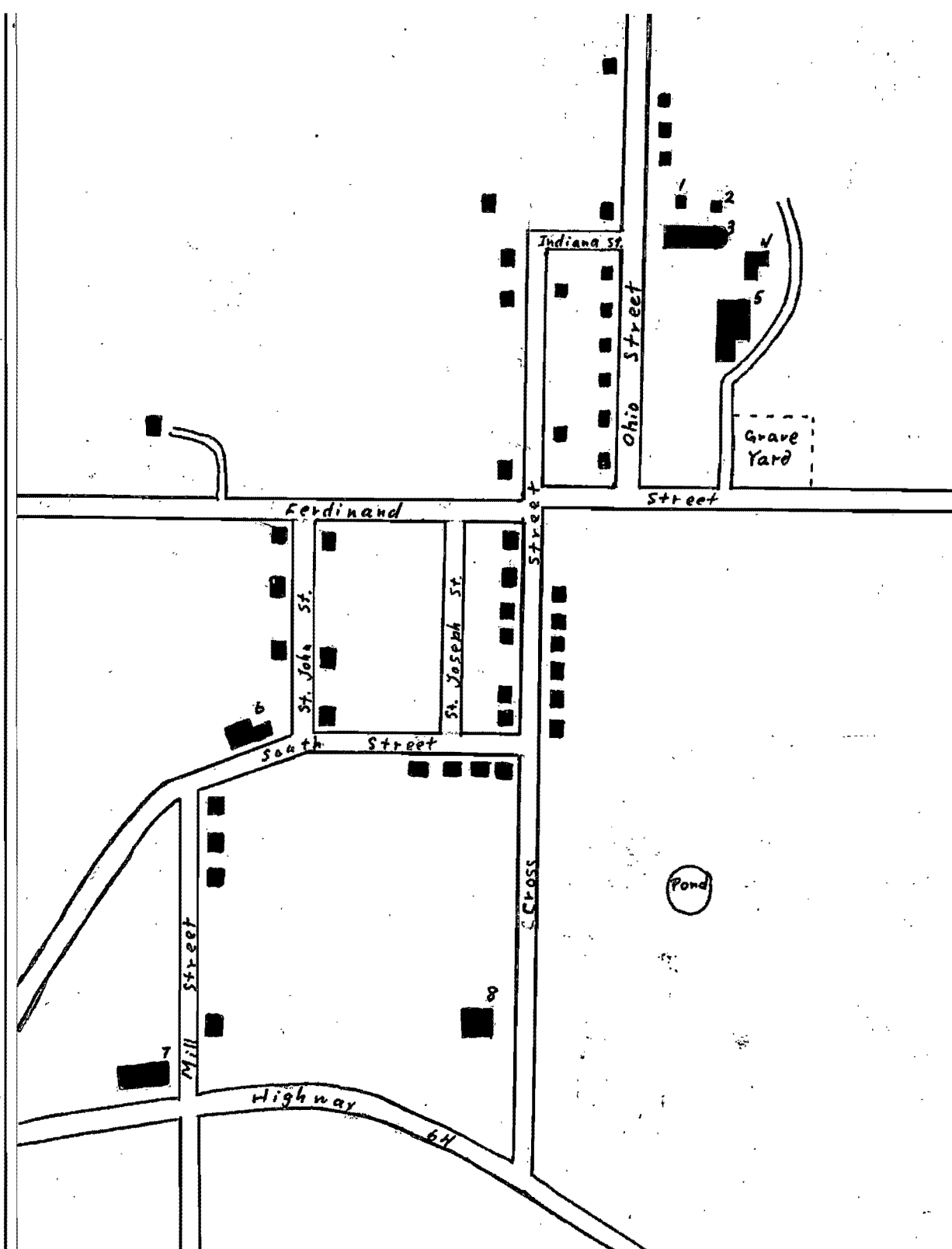
