



## Foreword


"Suscipe, sancte Pater . . . hanc immaculatam hostiam . . . ."



THE MOST REVEREND PAUL C. SCHULTE, D.D. Archbishop of Indianapolis

The motto on the coat of arms of His Excellency, Paul C. Schulte, D.D., archbishop of Indianapolis, sets forth in a simple way his aspiration as a man of God and a successor to the apostles: "Ad nutum reginae"—"At the Queen's command."

This is precisely what Archbishop Schulte has striven to do since his ordination in 1915—to be at the command of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Queen of Heaven, as a humble instrument in spreading the kingdom of her Divine Son, Jesus Christ.

Since his installation as head of the Indianapolis Archdiocese in 1946, His Excellency has established an impressive record as an administrator, priest, and teacher. By his work, prayers, and good example, he has molded his See into one of the finest in the Midwest.

The Archbishop's visits to St. Meinrad Seminary to bestow the priestly powers and to share his divine mission have truly been an inspiration for those seeking to follow the path to the priesthood.

"... Quam ego ... offero ... pro omnibus circumstantibus." These words from the Offertory of the Mass very aprly apply to our Father Archabbot Bonaventure, our spiritual father and leader, who presents to God the fruit of our labors as we stand about him.

Father Archabbot, born in 1918, came to St. Meinrad as a freshman in 1931 and entered the monastery after his second year of college. Ordained June 5, 1943, the young monk received his M.S. from Catholic University in 1946, after which time he continued his post graduate work at the University of Pittsburgh for three summers.

Teaching mathematics from 1946 to 1953, Father Archabbot also served as assistant manager at the Abbey Press and assistant spiritual director of the major seminary until his election as abbot on June 3, 1955. The Most Reverend Paul C. Schulte, D.D., archbishop of Indianapolis, officially blessed the abbot-elect the following August 31.


